2 culture be authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court
3 to make an investigation and study of current House documents
4 numbered 2346, 2737 and 2912.

5 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of
6 its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any,
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
8 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the
9 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
10 December, nineteen hundred and ninety-eight.
