AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PRESIDING OFFICER OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENFIELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The charter of the town of Greenfield is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out section 3.3 and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following section:—
- 4 3.3 The presiding officer of the Town Council shall be one of
- 5 its members, whose election shall occur at the Council's annual
- 6 organizational meeting. No person shall serve as presiding officer
- 7 for more than three (3) consecutive one (1) year terms.
