

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE REFORMATORY PRISON FOR WOMEN. Chap. 47

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding sixty-two thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the maintenance of the reformatory prison for women, for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and ten.

Appropriations, reformatory prison for women.

For the town of Framingham, toward the annual expense of maintaining and operating the system of sewage disposal at said prison, the sum of six hundred dollars.

Town of Framingham.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR MAINTAINING THE PRISON CAMP AND HOSPITAL. Chap. 48

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding forty-three thousand five hundred dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for salaries and expenses at the prison camp and hospital, for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and ten.

Appropriation, prison camp and hospital.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE STATE PRISON. Chap. 49

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding one hundred and sixty-eight thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the maintenance of the state prison, for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and ten.

Appropriation, state prison.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
