
To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:

Pursuant to the provisions of Article II, Section 8, Paragraph 1, Clause (2) of the Amendments to the Constitution, as amended by Article LXXXIX, I am filing for your consideration the attached legislation entitled, "An Act Relative to a Certain Easement in the Town of Wilmington."

Senator Tarr, Representatives Miceli and Murphy, and the Wilmington Board of Selectmen have asked me to file this legislation. It will authorize the Town of Wilmington, acting by and through its board of selectmen and conservation commission, to convey a certain easement through Town conservation land for the creation of a driveway to a private residence. Currently, access to that residence is limited to the parking lot of a private industrial park. The filing of this legislation was approved by the 1996 Annual Town Meeting in Wilmington.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO A CERTAIN EASEMENT IN THE TOWN OF WILMINGTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The town of Wilmington acting by and through its board of
2 selectmen and conservation commission is hereby authorized to
3 convey an easement to Dorothy Sullivan and Joseph M. Sullivan
4 to construct, operate, maintain, and use a driveway as laid out
5 on a plan entitled "Plan of Land in Wilmington, Mass. Showing
6 Proposed Easement Over Land of the town of Wilmington,
7 Scale 1" = 40', September 3, 1997, Merrimack Engineering
8 Services", on file with the conservation commission of the town
9 of Wilmington.
