

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF HAVERHILL TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN SPANS OR TRUSSES OVER AND ACROSS LITTLE RIVER IN SAID CITY. Chap. 96

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The city of Haverhill may construct and maintain a truss or trusses, span or spans, with necessary piers and abutments, over and across Little river in Haverhill, to be located at a point near the present Boston and Maine Railroad bridge known as "India Rubber Bridge", for the purpose of supporting and carrying across said river a city sewer.

The city of Haverhill may maintain trusses, etc., across Little river.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO CONFIRM THE VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE FIRST PENTECOSTAL CHURCH OF SOMERVILLE, MASSACHUSETTS. Chap. 97

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. All votes and proceedings of the First Pentecostal Church of Somerville, Massachusetts, at a meeting held in Somerville on April twelfth, nineteen hundred and nine, in lieu of the annual meeting, and all votes and proceedings of said First Pentecostal Church at the annual meeting held in said Somerville on December twentieth, nineteen hundred and nine, are hereby ratified, confirmed and made valid.

Confirming the votes, etc., of the First Pentecostal Church of Somerville.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ENJOINING OF UNAUTHORIZED FOREIGN FRATERNAL BENEFICIARY CORPORATIONS FROM DOING BUSINESS IN THIS COMMONWEALTH. Chap. 98

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The supreme judicial court or the superior court shall have power to restrain by injunction any foreign fraternal beneficiary corporation, association or society from the transaction of any business in this commonwealth, unless such corporation, association or society is authorized as provided in section thirteen of chapter one

Enjoining certain corporations from doing business in this commonwealth.
