AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISPLAY OF THE 9/4TH INFANTRY DIVISION
WORLD WAR II FLAG IN THE STATE HOUSE.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately provide for the display
3 of a certain flag in the state house, therefore it is hereby declared
4 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
5 of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The superintendent of state office buildings is hereby autho-
2 rized and directed to display the 9/4th Infantry Division World
3 War II flag with the flag of the 26th Infantry Division in a proper
4 case or cabinet, either in the Hall of Flags or Doric Hall. The flags
5 referred to herein shall not be removed from the state house
6 without the express permission of the general court.
