AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAXATION OF CERTAIN MILITARY ORGANIZATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (c) of section 1 of chapter 63A of the  
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1996 Official Edition, is hereby  
3 amended by adding the following clause:—

4 (3) organizations that serve as social clubs for members of the  
5 Massachusetts army and air national guard.

1 SECTION 2. Section 6 of chapter 64H, as so appearing,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word “ninety-three”,  
3 in line 362, the following:— meals served on the premises of  
4 organizations that serve as social clubs for members of the  
5 Massachusetts army and air national guard.
