### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF LOTTERY TICKETS AT THE SOLDIERS' HOME IN HOLYOKE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 27 of  
2 chapter 10 of the General Laws, or any other general or special  
3 law to the contrary, the canteen manager of the Soldiers' Home in  
4 Holyoke shall be allowed to sell lottery tickets or shares upon the  
5 issuance of a sales agent's license to said Soldiers' Home.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
