AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WAKEFIELD TO HOLD A CERTAIN SPECIAL ELECTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 11 of chapter 43B of  
2 the General Laws, or any other general or special law to the  
3 contrary, the town of Wakefield is hereby authorized to conduct a  
4 special election at which any proposed charter or charters recom-  
5 mended by the charter commission will be submitted to the voters  
6 of said town for their approval. Said special election shall be held  
7 on the date of and in conjunction with the biennial state election  
8 in the year 1998.
