AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALE OF RESEARCH PAPERS, ETC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 50 of chapter 271 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1996 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out in line eleven the word, “hundred”, and inserting in
4 place thereof the word:— thousand.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 271 of the General Laws, as so
2 appearing, is hereby further amended by adding the following new
3 section:—

4 Section 51. Educational institutions in the commonwealth may
5 seek injunctive relief for violations of section 50 of this chapter.
6 Such educational institutions may recover costs and attorneys’
7 fees incurred in pursuit of any such injunctions.
