

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE VILLAGE CEMETERY ASSOCIATION OF VINEYARD HAVEN.

Chap.155

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Tisbury is hereby authorized to hold, maintain, improve and embellish the village cemetery in the said town situated at the head of Holmes' Hole harbor in the village of Vineyard Haven.

The town of Tisbury may hold, etc., a certain cemetery in Vineyard Haven.

SECTION 2. The right to acquire the said cemetery which was conferred upon the Village Cemetery Association of Vineyard Haven by chapter one hundred and seventy of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-six, but was never exercised by the said corporation, is hereby transferred to the town of Tisbury, and the said town is hereby authorized to acquire the said cemetery by purchase or gift or by right of eminent domain.

Certain rights transferred to the town, etc.

SECTION 3. Said chapter one hundred and seventy of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-six is hereby repealed.

Repeal.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT AND REMOVAL OF CERTAIN OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF NEWTON.

Chap.156

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and thirty-five of the acts of the year nineteen hundred is hereby amended by striking out the words "with the consent of the aldermen", in the seventh line, so as to read as follows: — *Section 1.* The mayor and aldermen of the city of Newton shall appoint constables and all other boards and officers required by the laws of the commonwealth or by the ordinances of the city, whose selection is not otherwise provided for in the charter of said city or in special laws relating thereto, to hold office until they resign or are removed by the mayor. But this act shall not apply to the appointment or term of office of election officers.

Appointment, etc., of certain officers in the city of Newton.

SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the voters of the city of Newton at the next annual city election, and shall take effect if a majority of the voters voting thereon vote in the affirmative.
