SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap.179** AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PRINTING OF THE ANNUAL REPORT ON FIRES OF THE CHIEF OF THE DISTRICT POLICE.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Report of chief of district police on fires.

SECTION 1. The chief of the district police may annually have printed for distribution, with the approval of the insurance commissioner, additional copies of the annual report of his official action in the matter of fires, to a number not exceeding twenty-five hundred.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap.180** AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF HAVERHILL TO DISCONTINUE CERTAIN PUBLIC LANDINGS AND TO CONSTRUCT WHARVES ON THE MERRIMAC RIVER IN SAID CITY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

May discontinue certain public landings.

SECTION 1. The city of Haverhill may discontinue and close as public landings two city landings located on the Merrimac river, on the southerly side of Water street, in Haverhill, and shown as city landing number six and city landing number eight on plans on file in the office of the city engineer of Haverhill.

May construct wharves, etc.

SECTION 2. The said city may construct wharves or abutments on and deposit filling upon the land comprising said landings, and may extend such wharves, abutments and filling on the river side of said land to the harbor line established by chapter three hundred and twenty-seven of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and five. All work done hereunder shall be subject to the provisions of chapter ninety-six of the Revised Laws.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
