AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING BENEFICIARY UNDER THE RETIREMENT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The definition of "Beneficiary" in section 1 of
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1998 Official
3 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:—
4 Beneficiary may include a trust established for a disabled person.

1 SECTION 2. Section 12 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "member", in
3 line 148, the following:— provided, however, a trust established
4 for any of the forenamed who is disabled shall be eligible for
5 nomination as beneficiary hereunder.
