AN ACT RELATIVE TO VOTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 51 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 3 the following section:—
- 3 Section 3A. Every citizen who pays property tax on a second
- 4 home within the commonwealth shall be permitted to vote in local
- 5 elections and town meetings in the town of their second home.
