AN ACT RELATIVE TO BALLOT QUESTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6B of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1998 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following paragraph:—

4 No person, business, for profit or not-for-profit association, or
5 any other entity shall contribute more than \$100 in any calendar
6 year to the promotion or defeat of any ballot question or initiative
7 petition, so-called.
