AN ACT REVOKING THE SURCHARGE FOR CERTAIN MOVING VIOLATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The twelfth paragraph of section 113B of chapter
2 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1998 Official
3 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "laws" in
4 line 194, the following words:— Involving harm to persons or
5 property as a result of the moving violation.

1 SECTION 2. Said twelfth paragraph of said section 113B of
2 said chapter 175, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
3 striking out in lines 194 and 195 the following words:— including
4 payments pursuant to chapter ninety C.
