AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PRODUCTION AND PRESERVATION OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The definition of "Low or moderate income housing" in section
2 2 of chapter 40B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000
3 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following para-
4 graph:—

5 All housing units created under the provisions of this chapter
6 through the issuance of a comprehensive permit or approval,
7 regardless of whether said permit or approval has been approved
8 by the local board of appeals or by the housing appeals committee
9 in the department of housing and community development or by
10 the superior court, shall be counted in a community's subsidized
11 housing inventory.
