AN ACT RELATIVE TO ABUSE VIOLATIONS BY ALIENS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 209A of the General Laws as appearing in the 1998
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 5A
3 the following section:
4 Section 5B. Upon the conviction of an alien of a violation of
5 this chapter, the clerk of the court shall, forthwith, notify the
6 United States Naturalization Service of such conviction. If such
7 alien is deported, any restraining order issued may be subse-
8 quently extended upon notification to the United States Natural-
9 ization Service in behalf of the alien that a Judicial review will be
10 held to consider the continued justification for the restraining
11 order.
