AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF OUT-OF-STATE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSES AS VALID IDENTIFICATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 34B of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing  
2 in the 2000 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after  
3 the word “ninety”, in line 13, the following words:— or a valid  
4 photographic, nonduplicative motor vehicle license duly issued by  
5 any other state.
