RESOLVE TO PROVIDE A STUDY OF OUT OF STATE CHILD SUPPORT.

1 *Resolved*, That, notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the
2 Legislature will establish a working commission to study the
3 application, efficiency and results of the out of state child support
4 programs established by Chapter 5 of the Acts of 1995.

5 The Commission will consist of the Commissioner of the
6 Department of Revenue, the Chairman of Senate Ways and
7 Means, House Ways and Means and the Administrative Judge of
8 the Probate Court, or their designees.

9 The Commission will gather pertinent information and report to
10 the Senate and House Ways and Means Committees by January
11 31, 2004.
