SECTION 17. This act shall take effect upon its passage, but shall become void unless said water company shall have begun to distribute water through its pipes to consumers in said town within three years after the date of its passage.

Chap.487 AN ACT RELATIVE TO MATERIAL FOR THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF STATE HIGHWAYS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The Massa-
chusetts
highway
commission
may expend a
certain sum
for road
material, etc.

The Massachusetts highway commission is hereby authorized to expend a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars in any one year for the purpose of purchasing or acquiring land to obtain road material. Said sum may be taken from the money applicable to the construction or maintenance of state highways or from the Motor Vehicle Fees Fund, as the governor and council may from time to time determine.

Chap.488 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE ADVANCES OF MONEY TO THE MASSACHUSETTS HIGHWAY COMMISSION.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The Massa-
chusetts
highway
commission
may receive
advances of
money from
the treasurer.

SECTION 1. To carry out the provisions of law requiring weekly payments, and to secure cash discounts wherever possible, the Massachusetts highway commission may receive such advances of money from the treasury of the commonwealth as in the judgment of the auditor of the commonwealth are required for the said purposes.

Repeal.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap.489 AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DUTIES OF REFEREES SELECTED TO DETERMINE LOSSES UNDER POLICIES OF FIRE INSURANCE.

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the referees selected to determine the amount of loss under a policy of fire insurance, as set forth in the standard form of policy, to
