AN ACT RELATIVE TO SEALED RECORDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 100A of chapter 276 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 2000 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after
- 3 the word "court" in line 69 the following:— a victim of a crime
- 4 committed by the person whose record has been sealed.
