AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MASSACHUSETTS CULTURAL COUNCIL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 52 of chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 2000 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 first sentence the following sentence:— One of whom shall be a
4 public school arts teacher, 1 of whom shall be a public school
5 administrator, at least 1 of whom shall be from Suffolk or Mid-
6 dlesex county, at least 1 of whom shall be from Worcester county,
7 at least 1 of whom shall be from Essex county, at least 1 of whom
8 shall be from Norfolk, Bristol or Plymouth county, at least 1 of
9 whom shall be Hamden, Hampshire, Franklin or Berkshire county,
10 at least 1 of whom shall be from a small non-profit arts organiza-
11 tion with an annual operating budget of less than \$500,000.
