AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE REINSTATEMENT OF JOHN P. MOYLAN AS A MEMBER IN SERVICE OF A MASSACHUSETTS RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to  
2 the contrary, John P. Moylan shall be eligible to enroll as a  
3 member in service of the state retirement system as of the effec-  
4 tive date of this act; provided, however, that he shall repay to the  
5 state retirement system an amount equal to the total amount of any  
6 retirement allowance received by him together with interest  
7 thereon. Such repayment to be made in one sum or installments as  
8 the state board of retirement shall prescribe. Upon completion of  
9 such repayment, said John P. Moylan shall be entitled to cred-  
10 itable service for all periods for which deductions were made from  
11 his regular compensation.

12 Upon enrollment as a member in service of the state retirement  
13 system, said John P. Moylan, shall be eligible, upon the payment  
14 of regular deductions together with interest thereon to establish  
15 creditable service with the said system for the period of service  
16 during which he previously waived his retirement allowance. Such  
17 payment will be made in one sum, or in installments.

18 In the event said John P. Moylan shall again retire before the  
19 completion of made payments, he shall, in addition to credit for  
20 his actual membership service rendered since the date of his rein-  
21 statement hereunder, be entitled to credit for the portion of his  
22 payments actually made, together with regular interest thereon to

23 the date such retirement becomes effective, bears to the total  
24 amount of what his make-up payments, together with regular  
25 interest thereon to such latter date, would have been had he made  
26 payment thereof in one sum on such latter date. Any pension  
27 allowance, or other retirement benefit provided hereunder shall be  
28 exclusive of and in the alternative to any other pension,  
29 allowance, or other retirement benefit, including any provided for  
30 under general or special law.
