AN ACT PROVIDING GROUP INSURANCE TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF HAMILTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding chapter 32B of the General Laws or any other  
2 general or special law to the contrary, any call firefighter or  
3 reserve police officer in the town of Hamilton shall be deemed an  
4 “employee” as defined in section 2 of said chapter 32B and the  
5 spouse and children of each such call firefighter and reserve  
6 police officers shall be deemed a “dependant” as so defined in  
7 said chapter 32B.
