AN ACT RELATIVE TO CREDITABLE SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 32 of the General
2 Laws or special law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, and in
3 order to promote the public good, the state board of retirement
4 shall credit Ms. Kent Stasiowski of the City of Boston with addi-
5 tional creditable service for the period from March 1, 1994 to
6 March 1, 1995 during which time she served as an elected
7 member of the Wellesley Planning Board, for the purpose of
8 determining her eligibility and allowance for ordinary disability
9 retirement pursuant to the provisions of Section 6 of Chapter 32 of
10 the General Laws.
