AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF DEDHAM TO REIMBURSE CERTAIN  
SEWER FEES PAID IN ERROR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or  
2 by-law to the contrary, the town of Dedham may reimburse Geral-  
3 dine B. Bacon the sum of \$572.99 for the period of February 1989  
4 to May 1996, inclusive, and Clarke Coggeshall the sum of  
5 \$2,410.87 for the period of November 17, 1992 to May 15, 1996,  
6 inclusive, for sewer fees erroneously paid to said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
