

ordinate officers as may be provided for by the by-laws. The treasurer and the clerk shall each be elected for one year and until his successor is elected and qualified. The trustees shall be elected one each year for the term of seven years: *provided, however,* that at the first election one trustee shall be elected for one year, one for two years, one for three years and so on, respectively, and thereafter one trustee shall be chosen annually to serve seven years. Said trustees shall have the general management of the property, expenditures and affairs of said corporation and of the sale of lots in said cemetery, and shall make a report of their doings to the corporation at its annual meetings. If a vacancy occurs in said board of trustees, or in the office of treasurer or clerk, it may be filled for the unexpired term at any annual or special meeting of the corporation.

Proviso.

Damages, etc.

SECTION 8. Said corporation shall pay all damages sustained by any person or corporation by the taking of any land or other property or by any other thing done by said corporation under the authority of this act. Any person or corporation so injured and failing to agree with the cemetery corporation as to the amount of damages sustained may have the damages assessed and determined in the manner provided by law when land is taken for the laying out of highways, on application at any time within the period of one year from the taking of such land or other property or the doing of other injury under the authority of this act; but no such application shall be entertained after the expiration of one year.

SECTION 9. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 637 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS INCURRED FOR THE ERECTION AT ATTLEBOROUGH OF A BUILDING FOR THE FOURTH DISTRICT COURT OF BRISTOL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

§ 3, amended.

SECTION 1. Section three of chapter one hundred and twenty-five of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and eight, as amended by chapter three hundred and ninety-seven of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and nine, is hereby further amended by striking out said section and

inserting in place thereof the following: — *Section 3.* In order to meet the expenses incurred under this act, said county commissioners may borrow from time to time upon the credit of said county a sum not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, at a rate of interest not exceeding four and one half per cent per annum. This indebtedness shall be paid out of amounts received for taxes, at the rate of ten thousand dollars each year, beginning with the year nineteen hundred and eleven, until the whole indebtedness is paid.

County commissioners may borrow money, etc.

Payment of indebtedness.

SECTION 2. Chapter four hundred and eighty-four of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and ten is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SUNDRY SINKING FUNDS.

Chap. 638

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The sum of three hundred twenty-six thousand five hundred and seventy-one dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the benefit of the following sinking funds, to wit: —

Appropriations.

For the Armory Loan Sinking Fund, the sum of forty-seven thousand seven hundred and sixty-one dollars.

Armory Loan Sinking Fund.

For the Harbor Improvement Loan Sinking Fund, the sum of twenty-five hundred and fifty-six dollars.

Harbor Improvement Loan.

For the Massachusetts War Loan Sinking Fund, the sum of fourteen thousand and thirty-one dollars.

Massachusetts War Loan.

For the Medfield Insane Asylum Loan Sinking Fund, the sum of twenty-three thousand six hundred and eighty-six dollars.

Medfield Insane Asylum Loan.

For the Metropolitan Parks Loan Sinking Fund, boulevards, one half, the sum of thirty thousand eight hundred and four dollars.

Metropolitan Parks Loan.

For the Prisons and Hospitals Loan Sinking Fund, the sum of seventy-six thousand five hundred and ninety-six dollars.

Prisons and Hospitals Loan.

For the State Highway Loan Sinking Fund, the sum of seventy thousand two hundred and seventy-two dollars.

State Highway Loan.
