Resor relative to the transfer of a certain parcel of land located in the city of Marlborough and under control of the Department of Conservation and Recreation to the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance. State Administration.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRANSFER OF A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND TO THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL ASSET MANAGEMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The care, custody and control of a certain parcel of land, under  
2 the control of the Department of Conservation and Recreation,  
3 acquired for watershed purposes, most recently used by the Reg-  
4 istry of Motor Vehicles in the city of Marlborough, is hereby  
5 transferred to the Division of Capital Asset Management.

6 The reference plan used for the above described parcel is enti-  
7 tled Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Metropolitan District  
8 Commission, Water Division, Plan of Land in Marlborough, MA  
9 Scale 1 inch = 40 feet, May 24, 1928.

10 Said parcel is subject to a utility easement granted to the city of  
11 Marlborough, and recorded in the southern district registry of  
12 deeds, in the county of Middlesex at book 1287, page 69, plan  
13 #297 of 1975.
