The committee on Local Affairs and Regional Government, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4856) of William C. Galvin and Brian A. Joyce (by vote of the town of Canton) that said town be authorized to dispose of certain land located in the town of Canton and also in the town of Stoughton, and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4887) of Charles A. Murphy (by vote of the town) that the town of Burlington be authorized to charge a fee for the procurement of certain electronic records in the clerk's office of said town, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 5175) ought to be adopted.

1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Local Affairs and Regional
2 Government be authorized to sit during the recess of the General
3 Court to make an investigation and study of House documents
4 numbered 4856 and 4887, relative to authorizing the town of
5 Canton to use, or sell, convey or otherwise dispose of certain land
6 situated in the town of Canton and the town of Stoughton and to
7 the charging of a fee for records in the town of Burlington clerk's
8 office.

9 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of
10 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
11 together with any draft of legislation necessary to carry such rec-
12 ommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the
13 House of Representatives on or before December 31, 2004.
