AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE THAMES RIVER VALLEY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 17B of chapter 58 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 2002 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in
3 lines 8 and 9, the words “and chapter six hundred and thirteen of
4 the Acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-six” and inserting in place
5 thereof the following words:— chapter 613 of the Acts of 1956 or
6 chapter 616 of the Acts of 1957,.
