AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MAINTENANCE AND EXPANSION OF INDUSTRIES AND FARM SERVICES PROGRAMS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 71 of chapter 127 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out
3 the sentence contained in lines 9 through 11 and inserting in its
4 place thereof the following sentences: — Notwithstanding
5 the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the
6 department of correction may expend any and all revenues
7 accrued through its program of selling correctional industries
8 products and services, and may expend any and all revenues
9 accrued from the sales of farm products and services subject to
10 the approval of the commissioner of correction, for the support
11 of the abovesaid industries and farm programs including the cost
12 of materials, supplies, equipment, maintenance of facilities and
13 compensation of employees of said programs. Any remaining
14 balance at the end of the fiscal year of the amounts available to
15 be expended without further appropriation shall not revert to the
16 General Fund, but shall be available to said department of cor-
17 rection for the purposes provided herein during the subsequent
18 fiscal year.
