AN ACT EXEMPTING THE WORCESTER BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FROM THE SALES AND USE TAX IN DEVELOPING THE MEDICAL AND HIGH-TECHNOLOGY OR BIO-TECHNOLOGY RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT PARK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 317 of the acts of 1983 is hereby
2 amended by adding the following section: —

3 Section 7. Sales of building materials and supplies used in
4 construction, reconstruction, alteration, remodeling or repair of
5 any building, structure, public road or other public works owned
6 by said corporation in said park and for the purposes of said park
7 as described in this act shall be exempt from taxation under the
8 provisions of chapter sixty-four H and sixty-four I of the General
9 Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to the sale and use of building
2 materials and supplies on or after July twenty-sixth, nineteen
3 hundred and eighty-three.
