RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO PROVIDING STATE GRANTS FOR THE PROMOTION OF RECYCLING ACTIVITIES.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of two
2 members of the senate and three members of the house of
3 representatives and four persons to be appointed by the governor
4 one of whom shall be a member of a city or town recycling
5 committee, one of whom shall be a mayor of a city and one of
6 whom shall be a member of a board of selectmen for the purposes
7 of making an investigation and study relative to the feasibility of
8 providing state grants to cities and towns and municipal recycling
9 committees for the purpose of promoting recycling activities.

10 Said commission shall report to the house of representatives
11 the result of its investigation and study and its recommendations,
12 if any, together with drafts of legislation, if necessary to carry its
13 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of
14 the house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday in
15 December, nineteen hundred and ninety-three.
