AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRIES OF DEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 39 of Chapter 36 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following two sentences: — “The Hampden County Register of
4 Deeds, shall for the purposes of purchasing equipment or services
5 relative to electronic reporting, indexing computers and systems
6 designed to modernize, maintain registry records, and operation
7 of the Registry, retain the fees paid for plan copies. Each such
8 register shall, annually, furnish to the County Treasurer a
9 financial report regarding such interest and the expenditure
10 thereof in accordance with accepted accounting procedures.”
