By Mr. Teague of Yarmouth, petition of Edward B. Teague III relative to the membership of advisory councils established by the Education Reform Act. Education, Arts and Humanities.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF ADVISORY COUNCILS
ESTABLISHED BY THE EDUCATION REFORM ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 71 of the Acts of 1993 are hereby amended in Section 3
2 after the words: — “The members serving on such councils may
3 be school committee members, school superintendents, profes-
4 sional educators, parents or students.”, by adding the
5 following: — “At least 50 percent of the membership of all the
6 advisory councils shall consist of parents with school age
7 children.”
