AN ACT CLARIFYING CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR SABBATICAL LEAVES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 4 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end  
3 of subsection (1), the following new clause: —

4 (r) Creditable service in the case of any member shall include  
5 the period of any sabbatical leave awarded at a public institution  
6 of higher education regardless of whether the sabbatical leave is  
7 granted with full compensation or partial compensation.
