

By Mr. Scibelli of Springfield, petition of Anthony M. Scibelli relative to including certain environmental police officers in the Department of Fisheries, Wildlife and Environmental Law Enforcement in the career incentive pay program. Public Service.

AN ACT INCLUDING CERTAIN ENVIRONMENTAL POLICE OFFICERS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF FISHERIES, WILDLIFE AND ENVIRONMENTAL LAW ENFORCEMENT IN THE CAREER INCENTIVE PAY PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 108L of chapter 41 of the General
2 Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the
3 first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following
4 paragraph: —

5 Section 108L. There is hereby established a career incentive
6 pay program offering base salary increases to regular full-time
7 members of the various city and town police departments,
8 uniformed members of the department of state police appointed
9 under section ten of chapter twenty-two C, state police detectives
10 appointed under section ten of said chapter twenty-two C, and
11 environmental police officers appointed under the authority of
12 section six of chapter twenty-one, as a reward for furthering their
13 education in the field of police work.

1 SECTION 2. The fifth paragraph of said section 108L of said
2 chapter 41, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking
3 out the third sentence and inserting in place thereof the following
4 sentence: — The board of education shall also certify the amount
5 of the career incentive salary increases to be allocated to the
6 members of the department of state police appointed under
7 section ten of chapter twenty-two C, and environmental police

8 officers appointed by the authority of section six of chapter
9 twenty-one, from information filed with said board on or before
10 September first of each year by the colonel of state police for
11 members of the department of state police appointed under
12 section ten of chapter twenty-two C, and by the commissioner
13 of the department of fisheries, wildlife and environmental law
14 enforcement for the environmental police officers.
