AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN FEES FOR APPEALS TO THE APPELLATE TAX BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 6O the following section: —
- 3 Section 6P. A city or town which accepts this section may
- 4 provide for the payment of attorney's fees or appraisal fees
- 5 incurred by said city or town when abatement requests are
- 6 appealed to the appellate tax board from the overlay account
- 7 established pursuant to the provisions of section twenty-five of
- 8 chapter fifty-nine.
