AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 15 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the
- 3 end of the first paragraph the following: —
- 4 Notwithstanding the foregoing, no local licensing authority
- 5 shall prohibit the retail sale of certain types or brands of all
- 6 alcoholic beverages or beer and wine as the case may be, by any
- 7 person, firm, corporation, association, or other combination of
- 8 persons duly licensed pursuant to this section.
