## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Four.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PENALTIES FOR DRIVING AN UNINSURED VEHICLE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 34J of chapter 90 of the Massachusetts  
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby  
3 amended, in line 55, by striking out the words "sixty days", and  
4 inserting in place thereof the words "six months"; and by striking  
5 out, in line 65, the word "one", and inserting in place thereof the  
6 word "three".

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
