AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LABOR RELATIONS COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 150E, Section four is amended by
2 adding at the end of the second paragraph a new sentence: "The
3 Commission shall decide all representation questions under this
4 section within six months of the filing of any petition."

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 150E, Section six is amended by adding
2 a new paragraph after the first paragraph.
3 "Whenever the Commission is requested to decide a question
4 under this section, the Commission shall decide the question after
5 a full hearing within three months of the initial date of the filing
6 of the matter."
