AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENTS OF POLICE OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary  
2 superannuation retirements for police officers and firefighters in  
3 the Commonwealth shall be calculated as follows: Accrue 2.3%  
4 per year for the first 10 years of service; 2.7% for the next 10 years;  
5 and 3% per year for the next 10 year period resulting in a  
6 superannuation benefit of 80% after 30 years of service.
