RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO HEALTH SERVICES TO MINORITIES.

1     *Resolved*, That a special commission on services to minorities  
2 consisting of three members of the senate, three members of the  
3 house of representatives, and six persons to be appointed by the  
4 governor, one of whom shall be a physician licensed in the com-  
5 monwealth, one of whom shall be a registered nurse, and four of  
6 whom shall be executive directors of community health centers,  
7 is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation  
8 and study of the resources available to agencies and institutions  
9 which provide services primarily to neighborhoods where people  
10 of color live. Said commission shall include in its investigation  
11 and study methods for increasing such resources, the development  
12 of implementation strategies for all recommendations developed  
13 by the commission, and other issues related to the health field.
