## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PROVISION OF FAMILY CHILD CARE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 9 of chapter 28A of the General Laws, as appearing  
2 in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out,  
3 in line 35, the word "residence." and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following: — residence; provided, however, the family day care  
5 provider may care for up to ten children with no more than three  
6 children under the age of two if said provider has completed an  
7 additional five hours of specialized training approved by the office  
8 prior to approval, and completes an additional five hours of  
9 training per year thereafter, and has an approved assistant, and  
10 the family day care home size allows for an additional forty square  
11 feet of usable floor space per child over the number of six.
