AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE NECESSITY OF LIGHTS ON CERTAIN RECREATIONAL VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1992
2 Official Edition, is amended in section 24 by adding at the end
3 of the first paragraph the following sentence: — The provisions
4 of this paragraph shall not apply to so-called Y — all terrain
5 vehicles as agreed to in any consent decree under the auspices of
6 the federal court.
