AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DISTINCTIVE NUMBER PLATES FOR CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 section 139 of chapter 110 of the acts of 1993, is hereby further
3 amended by inserting after the tenth paragraph the following
4 paragraph: —

5 The registrar shall furnish at his office at no less than cost to
6 police officers who are drug abuser resistance education officers
7 plates bearing the letters DARE suitable for attachment to a
8 motor vehicle owned solely or in part by such officers.
