

HOUSE No. 1562

By Mr. LeLacheur of Lowell, petition of Edward A. LeLacheur and John F. Cox relative to certain benefits granted to former employees of the Commonwealth who are now county employees. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN BENEFITS GRANTED FORMER STATE EMPLOYEES NOW EMPLOYED BY THE COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, any employee of any
2 County Sheriff's Department [hired on or after January 1, 1991]
3 shall have credited to the County in which he/she is hired, any
4 prior state service including but not limited to time to retirement,
5 vacation status, accrued vacation days, accrued sick days. Such
6 credit [may be granted up to five (5) years from the date that state
7 service was terminated and] will be accepted by the County
8 personnel/retirement board in which County the employee was
9 hired.
