AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISPOSAL OF FEMININE HYGIENE DEVICES HAVING APPLICATORS MADE FROM SUBSTANCES WHICH ARE NOT BIODEGRADABLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 142 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing after section 42, the following section: —

3 Section 43. Whenever the Commonwealth, any agency,
4 authority, commission or political subdivision thereof under-
5 takes the construction, alteration, renovation, or repair of any
6 toilet facility designated for the use of females contained within
7 any public building including school houses, a closed waste
8 receptacle shall be provided in each stall.
