

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 1812

By Mr. Hall of Westford, petition of Geoffrey D. Hall relative to the professional status of public school teachers. Education, Arts and Humanities.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Four.

### AN ACT RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL TEACHER STATUS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 38G of chapter 71 of the General Laws,  
2 as amended by section 41 of chapter 71 of the acts of 1993, is  
3 hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (m) the following  
4 paragraph: —

5 Upon approval, employment while holding a provisional cer-  
6 tificate shall be credited as service for purposes of acquiring  
7 professional teacher status under section forty-one.

1 SECTION 2. Sections 38G of chapter 71 of the General Laws,  
2 as amended by section 41 of chapter 71 of the acts of 1993, is  
3 hereby amended by deleting the last sentence in the paragraph  
4 following paragraph (m) and inserting the following: — During  
5 the time that such a waiver is in effect, service of an employee  
6 of a school committee to whom the waiver applies shall be counted  
7 as service in acquiring professional teacher status under section  
8 forty-one.

1 SECTION 3. Section six of chapter seventy-one A of the  
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby  
3 amended by deleting the sentence appearing in lines 42 through  
4 48 and substituting therefor the following: — Service under such  
5 an exemption shall be credited to the teacher in acquiring  
6 professional teacher status under section forty-one of chapter  
7 seventy-one.
